- The network (several hundred network devices, 150 Wi-Fi access points),
- The services maintained by the group (nfs, samba, dhcp, dns, firewall, email, LDAP directory, VPN, Radius, HPC, openstack, backup),
- The storage systems (~1PB).

The main systems used are based on the following: Extreme Network for the network, Debian GNU/Linux for the operating system, and GPFS, ZFS and CEPH for storage.

You will be expected to play a part in one or more of the strategic projects currently under way:

- Overhaul of network architecture throughout the site,
- Centralisation and automation of network device configuration,
- Centralisation and automation of server configuration,
- Replacement of primary storage infrastructure for user data.
